Buschs Canon G1X manual is very cameraspecific with a minimum of generic tutorials and all of those closely tied to the camera. The writing is precise, crisp and light. I guess I like reading manuals, having plowed through Canons G1X Camera Users Guide, the G1X Cheat Sheet and Curtins A Short Course in Canon G1X Photography and earlier his G11 book, all before reading Busch. This is the one to buy and readcover to cover. This Canon is one of the most powerful cameras on the market thats not a DSLR. Unfortunately, Canon saw fit to only include a pdf version of the manual, which isnt exactly useful when youre learning how to use the camera.

And one problem I found with the G1 X manual, which is the same with all manuals on advanced cameras, it tells you how enable all the features of the camera, sometimes in excruciating detail. But rarely do these manuals tell you how each feature is used to allow you to take better photographs. This book is an outstanding guide to how to use the G1 X. The author provides a lot of step by step tutorials on how to use some of the features of the camera to get the best photographs. Im actually going through the book with my camera chapter by chapter, putting little tabs to mark pages to which I might refer in the future. The book actually has uncovered little features about the camera

that makes me more comfortable with my purchase. Im just starting to shoot some great photos and with the huge imaging sensor on the G1 X, you can get some amazing photos. One of the concerns about the camera was its ability to shoot sports action shots, but the book shows how to set up the camera to get some wonderful shots. Ive incorporated some of the books ideas into how Im setting up the camera. What I particularly love about this book is that the author appears to have spent a lot of time with the camera. The book is for people who want to make the most out of their G1 X. I think that even professional photographers wouldnt mind having the book as a reference in case some obscure menu on the camera doesnt quite make sense. But the book helps you learn how each feature can assist you in taking better photographs. Will this book turn you into a pro overnight. Of course not. But it does one thing well it gives you the opportunity to learn how to get there. I think if youre buying a Canon G1 X on Amazon, this ought to be in your cart as well. Miles better than the User Guide that comes with the camera. Busch is authoritative and balanced. Highly recommended. In the next edition I would make the following changes 1.

I would be a lot clearer about what focus mode and what metering mode is the best for different kinds of uses. The classes of uses I suggest are family photos; landscapes; urban travel photos of people and buildings; and photos of the interior of museums and churches. A table could present this information. The text could give the reasons why. This is a remarkable camera for its insanely good image quality, superb low light performance in a 4x zoom compact camera. Why not let the reader realize what his or her camera is. Computer handbook writers often do this. 3. David Busch rarely uses the LCD in the articulation position, but forgets that this is a major reason people buy the camera. The articulating screen is an immense help in composition and color for almost all photos, not just for very low or overhead camera positions. I would add a sentence or two telling how good it is for composition. 4. A certain lightness of tone, as in the Dummies books, would relieve the M.I.T. quality, if David can manage it. I say all this with the recognition that this is a camera guide of outstanding quality by a highly knowledgeable author. David Buisch is the dean of camera quidebook writers and this is a truly excellent book. No user should be without it. Elwood DowdI have both books and this is one of them and probably the best. Of the 2 books I prefer this one because it provides examples of where and under what circumstances to use most of this cameras huge set of features. A user guide describes what to do to use a particular feature but it stops there. This book, despite being described as a paperback is, in reality, a substantial book and not the sort of publication that can be slipped into the average coat pocket, unless it is fitted with a large poachers pocket. I would summarise this book as a user guide, with examples, which would be of considerable use to a photographic amateur or expert alike.

The Canon Powershot G1X is now comfortably the most sophisticated camera in my collection and I carry its user guide mainly as a memory jogger to its controls and features. However, despite many decades of using cameras, some of the newer photographic features need explaining when memory jogging fails.
